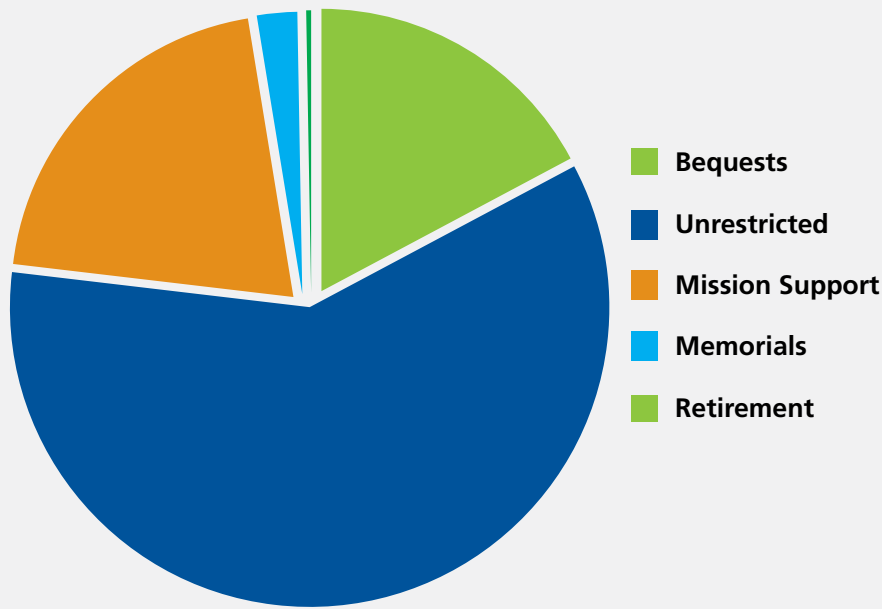

Celebrating Unity

From the founding moment a spirit of unity has gifted the Sisters of the Presentation. From the heart of foundress Nano Nagle in Ballygriffin to Mother Vincent Hennessey in Mooncoin, Ireland, prior to 1875, for the last 140 years and into the future, a sense of unity permeates through time, through place, through events and through people in a synergy of vision, mission and direction.

Partners – didn't have to be called. They were drawn. One might easily calculate that thousands upon thousands of people have partnered to live in the spirit that impelled Nano Nagle. This solidarity of heart reveals different people at different times and in different places co-creating to transform themselves and the world.

What did this co-creating look like? It took the form of three young women risking to leave Ireland to teach in America, Visitation Sisters welcoming Presentation women, Kate O'Hea's gift of bread ... collaborating with and being transformed by others – consciously.

Fostering Partnerships

Imagine this, you are thirsty. You go to the tap to pour a glass of water. Your water comes out a bit mucky and rusty in color.

- Do you know what you are drinking?
- Do you feel safe consuming this?

When it comes to safe water, for the indigenous Guarani people of Bolivia, there is no choice. This is the only liquid available and they must drink it to stay hydrated. The 2014 Golden Jubilarians initiated a life changing project, called "Water with Blessings," in honor of their celebration. "Like the Samaritan woman who was moved to action and returned to evangelize her village, we, too, felt called to action. For action flows out of contemplation," stated Sister Elena Hoye.

"Water with Blessings" was designed to enhance the capacity of local people to solve their need for safe water. The filtration device cleans the water, making it drinkable. Each kit costs approximately \$50, plus



shipping. The ambitious goal of the Jubilarians was to provide 50 kits, celebrating 50 years of religious life.

Your partnership in this project made it possible for HUNDREDS of the water filtration devices to be installed in the homes and public services of the Guarani. Thank you. Your gift makes a difference!

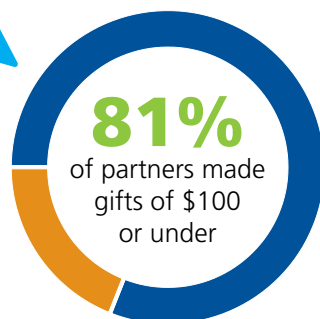

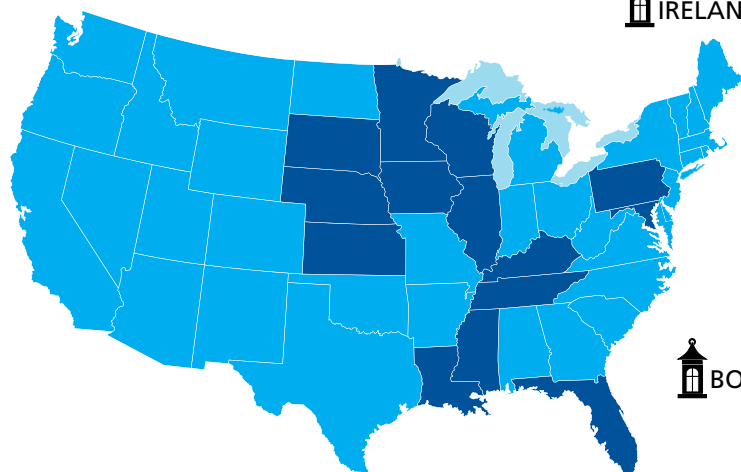
